## WHERE TO PARK? WHAT TO DO?

Greetings, Festival Friends! Welcome to the Pocono Dulcimer Festival 2024! Here is some helpful information as you arrive, park your car, and make your way to the Festival Registration, workshops, vendors, concerts, jams, food, and more!

## **FESTIVAL PARKING**

There are a number of parking areas / lots around the church and nearby, in addition to available parking on the street. There are some free parking spaces around the church building, but most parking will be metered (lots and street). **IF YOU ARE mobile, Please park in the Metered Parking areas and leave the Parking closest to the Church for those with mobility issues.** When you arrive, we suggest you unload your instruments at the back of the church (Volunteers will be there to assist and guide you). You can then go park your car and walk to the back of the church building to get to Registration; or you can, park your car and then return to enter the church building.

**FP** = FREE PARKING: a few free spots are available around the church (back and sides): Unload / Enter at back of church for stairs / elevator - use for main entrance to Festival

**MP** = METERED PARKING: [9 AM – 5 PM Mon – Fri] available in various lots and on streets near the church. **Download the Parking Passport App** to use at metered parking spaces. [Download the App <u>before</u> you arrive and set up your payment option(s).] The App appears fairly easy to use and it will save you walking back and forth to feed the meter.
